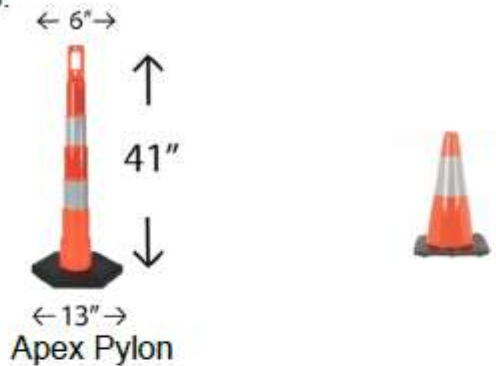

3. Chicanes

The pylons used for the chicanes are shown below; the smaller ones are standard 14" high ones.



It is not the intention of the organizers to create a scoring debacle, but to slow the cars down commensurate with ARA rules.

It is the intention of these chicanes to get competitors down into first gear to negotiate them.

Penalties: (as ruled by the judge of fact at the chicane)

10 seconds = dislodging or knocking over of an element

30 seconds = for putting 2 wheels on the wrong side of the large pylon (similar to straddling a gate in a slalom)

60 seconds = for complete disregard of the chicane.

DISTANCE BETWEEN ELEMENTS = APPROX. 28 FT = 10 PACES

The layout of the chicanes on a stage are shown after the map of that stage that precedes the stage instructions.
